Where we are

The Brighton and Hove Food Partnership offices are located at Community Base (*please note: although the Community Kitchen on the corner of North Road and Queens Road is our project, our offices are not there*).

When you arrive, please go to Community Base reception. Let them know you are here to see the Food Partnership. The receptionist will greet you and contact us, you will be allowed to use the bathroom if you need it and take a seat while you wait. We will come down and meet you and travel with you to our part of the building.

Finding Community Base reception

The Reception entrance is next to the Community Kitchen on Queens Road. The reception entrance has a Community Base logo above the door and is the first Community Base entrance you will reach as you travel down from the station towards the seafront. There is a photo below.

The Reception entrance has two automatic doors. Push buttons are located on left hand side of doors outside and inside reception, this will open both doors.



Finding the South Wing entrance

In case you need it, the entrance to the part of the building we are located in, South Wing, is the next door on the right of the Community Base reception entrance. The doors open from the inside, and the lift is to the left. We are on the first floor. A photo of the entrance to South Wing is below:



How to travel to us

By train:

We are easily accessible by foot from Brighton Rail Station. Simply walk straight down Queen Road towards the town/ seafront, we are located just past the intersection with North Road. Look for our large windows onto the main street. The walk takes less than 5 minutes.

By bus:

A large number of Brighton & Hove bus routes stop nearby to the Community Kitchen, either at Churchill Square Shopping Centre or at Brighton Station. Explore local [bus maps and timetables here](#).

By car:

The nearest car park is the [RCP parking](#) on North Road, which charges a flat rate of £5.50 after 5pm. For daytime parking, the most affordable central car park option is on [Trafalgar Street](#), charging £8-9 for up to 4 hours.
